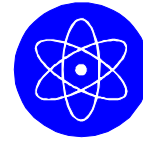

- Ø Disadvantaged Student Support – student achievement awards with financial support, computer and equipment donations to individuals, schools & welfare organizations, donation of books and other educational resources.
- Ø School Scholarships – To assist disadvantaged students get through!
- Ø Sports Access Program – assisting disadvantaged children and families to gain access to sports events and participate in sports programs egg. Junior sports courage awards, sports ticket program, sports equipment donation etc.
- Ø Abused & "At Risk" Children's Projects – Leaving state care support, child protection access rooms project, toy/clothing/equipment donation, access to professional therapists free of charge.
- Ø Equipment Donation Project – art equipment to art therapy groups, books to child care centre's, desks to disadvantaged schools, cots to young mums groups, children's videos/DVD's to waiting areas in govt.

- Ø Children Leaving State Care – support to young people leaving state care, financial and material aid, counseling and mentor support.
 - Ø Refugee & Migrant Support – targeted student awards, donation of equipment, targeted recipients of free access to entertainment project.
 - Ø Missing Relative/Friend Tracing Service – many successful re-unions.
 - Ø Public Health – Financial and material aid to families with serious/terminal illness issues egg. financial aid package (\$6000) for child liver transplant patient, community advocacy on various health committees, toys for child surgery patients, dental hospital children's soft toy project.
 - Ø Access To Entertainment Project – Free tickets to a myriad of events for disadvantaged families egg. Circus, magic shows, theatre etc.
 - Ø Homelessness & Foster care – Foundation members involved with Centre for Excellence in Child and Family Welfare, Home sharers – Foster care, Foster care Association of Victoria, Australian Institute of Family Studies.
 - Ø Self-Esteem Programs – “Makeovers” for young women with self image issues egg. Chronic and terminal illness.
 - Ø Pre-Employment Support – Assistance with resume writing, linking to work experience/pre-employment options egg. Mechanic for a day program, pre-interview presentation skills project for young women.
 - Ø Mentor Program – Mentoring disadvantaged youth by matching with suitable mentor leaders from various sectors.
 - Ø Planting The Seed Project – Seed and capital funding, in-kind support and capital equipment for small community groups who are doing great community building work.
 - Ø Training, Education & Research – Foundation members are registered with National Child Protection Clearing House, National Assoc. for the Prevention of Child Abuse & Neglect, Aust. Institute of Family Studies, Aust. Psychology Society, Aust. Assoc. of Social Workers, Vic. Assoc. of Family Therapists.

We are always very grateful for your support; raffle prizes, equipment, volunteer time, attending and sponsoring our annual charity ball, connecting us with those who can help our program, and of course, your generous financial support.
